

WILL WE SUPPORT LOW-POWER FM RADIO?

Low-Power FM radio runs off of 100 watts and has a range of 3-5 miles. LPFM station licenses can only be granted to non-commercial groups such as religious, educational, civic, and neighborhood organizations.

*HERE'S WHY YOU SHOULD CO-SPONSOR, SUPPORT, AND VOTE YES
ON THE LOCAL COMMUNITY RADIO ACT (HR2802 & S1675):*

- There is unused spectrum which community organizations are currently prohibited from using.
(See The Radio Broadcasting Preservation Act)
- Past technical concerns about interference have been proven not to be an issue.
(See: Low-Power FM: The Facts Are in...)
- All five FCC Commissioners unanimously support the expansion of LPFM.
(See "FCC Adopts New Rules to Promote Growth.")
- The Senate version (S1675), introduced by Senators McCain and Cantwell, unanimously passed out of Committee and has been co-sponsored by Senator Barack Obama.
- The House of Representatives version of this legislation (HR2802), introduced by Representatives Doyle and Terry, has received widespread support with nearly 100 co-sponsors from across the aisle.
- National Grassroots, Civil Rights, Christian, Educational, and Community Organizations across the country are insisting that Congress meet the demand for Local Community Radio.
